

## Categories

### Safety

- All participants **MUST** wear scrubs during workshop.
- You **MUST** wear **PROTECTIVE GARMENTS** during the lab, ie. scrub hat, mask with face shield or protective eye wear, gown and gloves. This is for **YOUR** protection, it is not necessary to have sterile products.
  - These are available in the room to the left.
- **PLEASE** Protect yourself as it relates to sharps.
- Place all sharps in the sharps container.
  - Sharp containers are available on counters.
- **EYE RINSE** area is in the sink. Flush eyes immediately if particles get in your eyes.

### Supplies

### Maintenance

- Instrument usage – basic surgical instruments will be on your field. Instrumentation and case specific instruments will be given to you as you need them from the set. **DO NOT place instruments back into the trays** after use, or go searching for instruments on your own.
- Instruments are to not leave the lab at any time.
- **REMOVE** all implants from specimen at the end of the procedure.
- Shut off all equipment before leaving.
- Clean up all tissue and place in bio-hazard bag and label waste and place back in freezer.
- Label all specimens in freezer for re-use.

### General

- Coat racks are available in the room on the left as you enter. Please use these racks to hang up any personal items.
  - UK is not responsible for any personal items that are left in the surgical lab.
- Food and drink are not allowed in the lab area.
- Please be courteous and place all garbage in receptacles that have been provided.
- You must check with the lab staff before you decide to do additional procedures on the specimen. Specimens are multi use and may not be available for additional procedures.
- All junior residents and medical students must be accompanied by a chief resident.
- Do NOT leave the lab with dirty gloves. Do **Not** touch any equipment other than necessary for the procedure with your gloves! i.e... phone, computer, etc.
